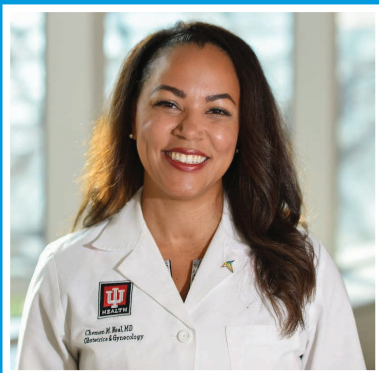
Central Library | 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
