BECOME A MEMBER OF THE EARN AND LEARN PROGRAM

EARN AND LEARN MEMBERSHIP

- Any Library card holder under the age of 18 with \$5.00 or more of debt is eligible.
- Apply in person at any Library location.
- At application, new members will be issued a special Earn and Learn card to track reading credit and debt reduction.
- **Members must remain in the program for one year, even if all debt is read or paid off.**
- Each member is responsible for his or her Earn and Learn card.

USING LIBRARY MATERIALS AND SERVICES

- As an Earn and Learn Member, you may use your Library card to borrow books, magazines, CDs and audiobooks.
- Limit 10 items at any time.
- DVDs are not eligible.
- You may place holds and access Library computers

RETURNING MATERIALS ON TIME FOR CREDIT

- Please return your Library materials to the library's drop box.
- Take your Earn and Learn card to the desk and tell a staff member how much time you have read since your last visit.
- You may include time spent reading books and ebooks, as well as time spent listening to audiobooks.

EARNING POINTS AND ELIMINATING DEBT

The more books you read and return on time, the more minutes you earn. Library staff will clear fines from a member's Library card at the following point levels:

300 minutes = 25%

600 minutes = 50%

900 minutes = 75%

1200 minutes = 100%

Upon reaching 1200 minutes and maintaining membership for one year, the member will become a Library card holder in good standing and all borrowing privileges will be restored.

Summer Reading bonus! Join the Summer Reading Program, receive a separate Summer Reading point card and also receive prizes for your reading efforts! During the Summer Reading Program, IndyPL will issue a free replacement card to kids and teens 6-17 who have lost their Library cards.
